4. There were no Minutes from the December 4, 2018 meeting.

#### 5. Reports

<u>Treasurer:</u> The Current Assets are \$88,661.77. See attached.

Carol Sonnenberg moved to accept the Treasurer's Report. Bonnie Pierce seconded the motion. Accepted unanimously.

<u>Trustees</u>: Carol Sonnenberg moved that Richard Mullis be granted a maximum of \$2,000 for labour and parts to renovate the bathrooms to make them wheelchair accessible. David Wood seconded the motion. Accepted unanimously.

Don Smith reported that a car ran into the fence but that he was able to repair the damage.

#### Directors:

House on Morlock had the trailer removed and a new roof and siding were replaced. House on Orange Dr. was raided and squatters were removed.

1930 Pleasure and 2 more houses on Pleasure the Sheriff investigated for drugs. It was requested that a map be included.

<u>Security Committee:</u> More volunteers are needed. The next meeting is scheduled at the North Hall for January 10, 2019. If anyone sees any suspicious activity, please call the Sheriff or Pasco County directly.

<u>BVA - Covenants:</u> There is a meeting scheduled for January 21, 2019 to discuss if those owners with delinquent accounts (approximately 100) should have voting rights with respect to the proposed amendments.

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The next general meeting is to be held with the lawyer in two weeks. The date will be posted.

It was noted that although the North and South are separate Home Owners' Association (HOA) there will be one Covenant for both.

### 6. Matters Arising

6.1 <u>Garbage Contract</u>: We have signed a new contract so that as of February 1, 2019 our garbage will be picked up by "All Haul". Note that only those who are current with their fees will receive garbage pick up. We will continue to have 2 garbage pickups per week plus a weekly recycling collection on Wednesdays. On the last pickup of the month we can put out large items like furniture, mattresses, etc. NO electronics, batteries, tires or appliances will be accepted. Individuals will have to dispose of these in the Waste Facility in Hudson.

<u>Pancake Breakfast:</u> The price has increased to \$4, the same as the North Hall. Date is Saturday January 19. Sign-up sheets are at the back of the Hall.

6.2 <u>Financials (Ameri-Tech)</u>: We should have been receiving monthly payments from Ameri-Tech. The last payment was received in September. A meeting has been scheduled to address the issue.

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6.3 <u>Club House Usage:</u> Owners can contact Carolyn Smith or Bonnie Pierce to book an event. There is a \$50 deposit required, which will be

returned if the hall is left in good order. \$10 of the deposit will be kept if the event takes place on a Sunday or in the summer.

- 6.4 Clara Alfonsi made a motion that only those who are paid members in the South HOA are allowed to rent our hall. The fee would be \$50 deposit and the Executive Board can use their discretion to make an exception. Norm Berry seconded the motion. There were 29 in favour and 2 opposed. Motion carried.
- 6.5 <u>Welcome Packages:</u> Bonnie Pierce has been working on this project. She and the new Secretary will continue the project.
