All-Haul Waste Services, Inc.

As of February 1, 2019 we now have a new Waste Collection Service for our Community. All-Haul will start waste collection on 2/4/2019 which is the first regular collection day for our community. The description of services is outlined below.

Description of Services

The Contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment, and other items required to provide residential waste and recyclables collection as follows.

- A. Solid waste collections to be made twice per week, on Monday and Thursday.
- B. Recycling collected WEEKLY on Wednesday.
- C. Collections to begin no earlier than 5:00 AM.
- D. No limit on number of items collected, not to exceed 2 cubic yards per collection.
- E. Brush under 5ft. in length, tied in bundles: grass and leaves containerized.
- F. Bulky items, Furniture etc. will be collected on route when possible, multiple items or exceptionally large or heavy items may be subject to an additional charge as determined by the contractor and Buena Vista.
- G. Items excluded from collection include: Tree Stumps, Tires, Auto Batteries, Bricks, Chemicals, Flammable Liquids, Explosives, Biomedical Medical Waste and other materials deemed unacceptable by the Pasco County Solid Waste Authority.
- H. White goods (Appliances) and Television sets collected separate from the regular trash at rate of \$15.00 Per Item. Collection arrangements made by customer.
- I. The Contractor's Scheduled Holidays are: Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. Should a collection day fall on a holiday NO COLLECTION will be made. Collections will resume on the next scheduled collection day.
- J. The contractor shall be responsible for any damage to property, roadways, or common areas, due to negligence or carelessness of its employees, and shall repair said damage, or contract with a reliable third party to make repairs.
- K. The contractor will maintain its vehicles in a clean and safe condition.
- L. Collection at parks, pools, clubhouses, etc., at no charge.
- M. Contractor will perform a special bulk pick up of items on the last Saturday of each month at no additional charge. Terms and conditions to be mutually agreeable between both parties.
