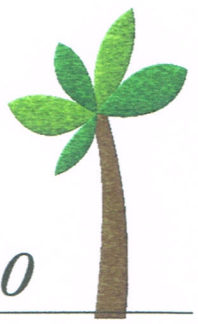

# All-Haul (Garbage & Recycling) Information

All-Haul 727-847-2420

As some of you might be aware there is a lot of trash not being picked up in the park. This summer we implemented that if your bill is not paid.... service will be suspended it's as simple as that. If you are getting tired of seeing all the trash your only recourse as of now is to call county code enforcement.

There is a 5bag limit so if you put more out to the curb it won't be picked up. Everything should be bagged and in a garbage can. DO NOT put dead animals, syringes with needles, etc. in your garbage can. It is a health and safety danger not only to us but the All-Haul workers. Weight limit is 50 pounds.

Put your trash can(s) at the end of your driveway only. NOT by mailbox, behind bushes, etc.

On the last Saturday of every month is big item pick-up only. NO tv's, appliances, tires. This is for a few items only not a whole house. DO NOT put item(s) out at the curb until the night before.

There is a change as to what recycling will pick up now. \* See flyer below

Call your trash hauler for a schedule or to order a cart. Pasco County does not pick up your recycling.

## Why No Glass?

Glass is expensive to process and there is no viable market for recycled glass in Florida. When glass breaks it creates a contaminant for other materials and makes them more difficult to recycle. To reduce costs and increase the recyclability of the overall stream, glass is no longer accepted.

## Why No ?

We can only accept the items listed because the machines that separate recycling are only designed for certain items. Anything else can cause the machines to slow down or even break.

**When in doubt, throw it out!**
