#### Buena Vista Adventure Inc. Updates

The Property Manager as of April. 2020 is managing 41 active violations.

#### Maple Sugar Ginger Roast Pork

2 1/2 Lb. boneless pork loin roast, tied

2 tablespoon maple sugar, See note

1/4 teaspoon crushed red pepper

1/2 teaspoon kosher salt

2 clove garlic, thinly sliced

1 1/2 teaspoon finely grated fresh ginger

2 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil

Blood orange slices, red currants, and sprigs of mint for garnish.

Using a knife, make thin slits all over roast & slip a garlic slice into each one. In a small bowl, mix maple sugar with ginger, salt, red pepper and olive oil. Rub paste all over pork, wrap well in plastic and refrigerate overnight in a small roasting pan; let stand at room temperature for 1 hour before roasting. Preheat oven to 450 degrees. Roast pork for about 10 minutes. Lower the oven temperature to 400 degrees. and roast pork for 35 minutes more., until an instant-read thermometer inserted in the thickest part registers 135 degrees. Transfer roast to a cutting board and let rest for 15 minutes before slicing. Discard the string and carve the pork into thin slices. Arrange on a platter, garnish with the orange slices, red currants and mint and serve.

NOTE: Maple sugar, made from reduced maple syrup, is available at specialty-food stores. Alternatively, use granulated brown sugar.
