Article IV– OFFENSES INVOLVING PPEACE AND ORDER

SECS. 66-78—66-90 DIVISION 2—NOISE

(7)Noises created by radios, television sets, exterior loudspeakers, and similar devices.

a In the case of any radio receiving set, musical instrument, television, phonograph, drum, exterior loudspeaker, or other device for the production or reproduction of sound, it shall be unlawful to create or permit to be created any noise that exceeds 66 dBA during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., 60 dBA during the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., and 55 dBA during the hours of 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., measured from the property line of thenoise source.

b.It shall also be unlawful to operate or permit the use or operation of any radio receiving set, musical instrument, television, phonograph, drum, exterior loudspeaker, or other device for the production or reproduction of sound in such a manner as to cause noise disturbance so as to disturb the peace, quiet, and comfort of the neighborhood and vicinity thereof
