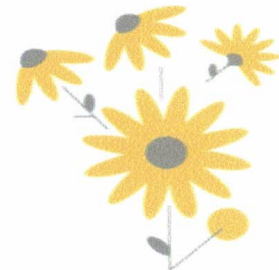

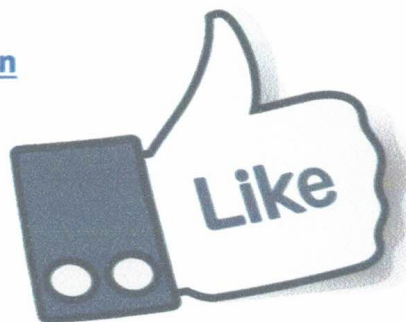

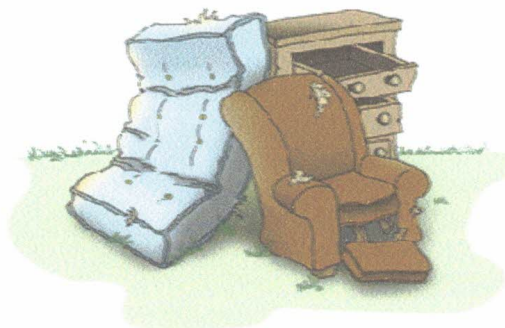


NO GLASS

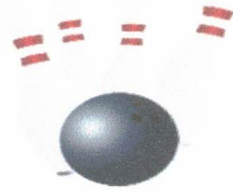
