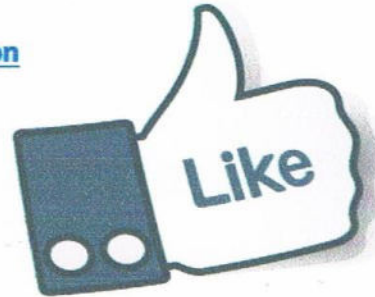

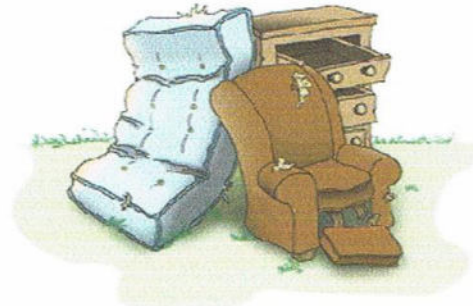


NO GLASS

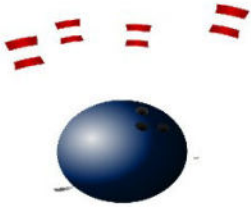
Big item pick up in January is on the 25th.

PASCO COUNTY RECYCLING PROGRAM

We accept aluminum cans in our program. Recycling just one aluminum can saves enough energy to power a standard laptop for two hours!

You can recycle metal food can. Does the top have a pull tab? Can you use a can opener? You can recycle it!

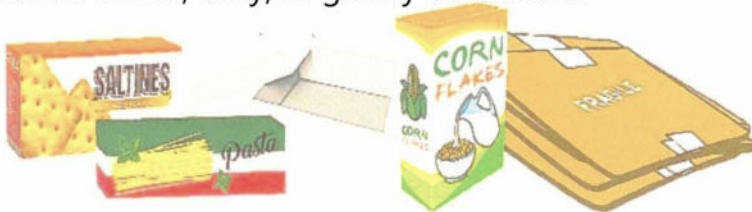
Please make sure cans are clean and dry!



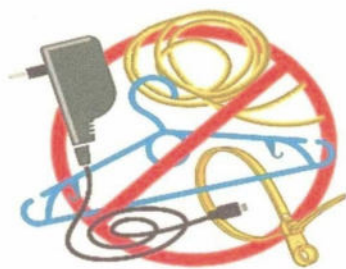
We love cardboard! Please make sure your cardboard is clean and dry. Once cardboard becomes wet, the fibers begin to break down and it can no longer be recycled. Pasco can recycle your corrugated cardboard (please flatten), cereal boxes (without the bag), tissue boxes, toilet paper tubes, paper towel tubes, pasta boxes, etc.

We accept newspaper, office paper, junk mail, magazines, wrapping paper, and card stock. Please make sure your paper is clean and dry. Once paper becomes wet, the fibers begin to fall apart, and it can no longer be recycled.

Please no soiled, dirty, or greasy cardboard.
