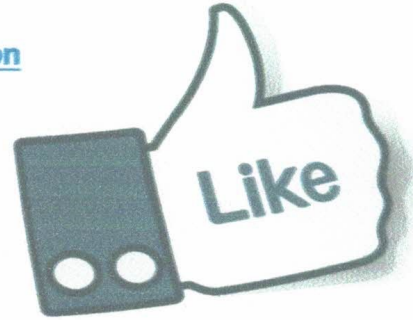

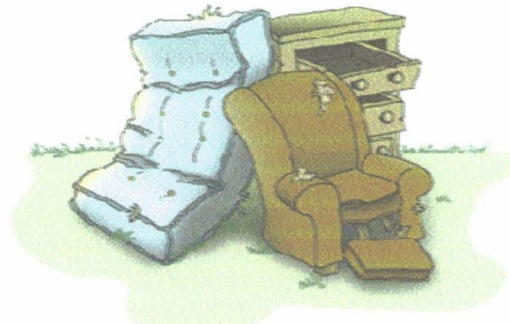


NO GLASS

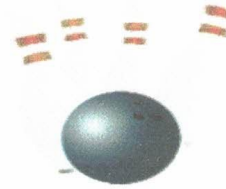
Big item pick up in March is on the 28th.
