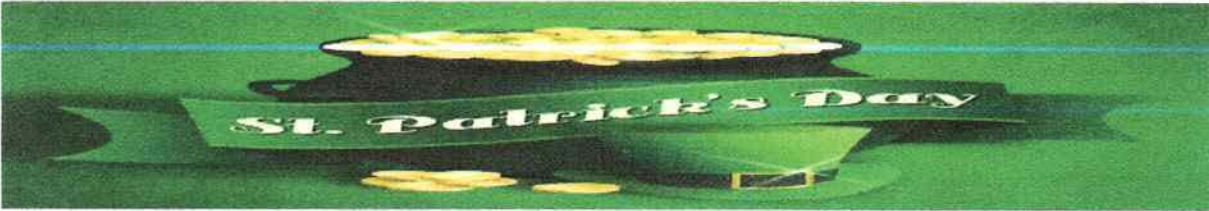

1. With the help of Officer Fragga, (who works nights) we defined escalation procedures when we encounter suspicious/criminal activity:
 - Suspicious activity Tip line: (When you document suspicious activity but do not actually see a crime being committed.) (Anonymous)

 - 1-800-706-2488
 - Non-Emergency criminal activity: (When you actually witness and document criminal activity that does not immediately endanger persons or property.)
 - 727-847-8102
 - If there is immediate danger to persons or property: Call 911. If you have already had a conversation about a situation with a specific officer (For example a known drug house) and that officer gave you his/her phone number) Call the office directly.
2. We have discussed the need to work closely and proactively with code enforcement. 727-847-8171. We asked Sandy to research/and provide us guidance on this item at the next meeting.
3. We discussed making "Neighborhood watch" magnet signs available to those members who want them.
 - If I recall correctly, Sandy said she could bring them to the next meeting.
4. Officer Fragga will attend our meetings as his schedule permits. We will give him the meeting floor for the first 15 minutes of every meeting he can attend.
