- 1. With the help of Officer Fragga, (who works nights) we defined escalation procedures when we encounter suspicious/criminal activity:
- Suspicious activity Tip line: (When you document suspicious activity but do not actually see a crime being committed.) (Anonymous)

- 1-800-706-2488
- Non-Emergency criminal activity: (When you actually witness and document criminal activity that does not immediately endanger persons or property.)
- 727-847-8102
- If there is immediate danger to persons or property: Call 911. If you have already had a conversation about a situation with a specific officer (For example a known drug house) and that officer gave you his/her phone number) Call the office directly.
- We have discussed the need to work closely and proactively with code enforcement. 727-847-8171. We asked Sandy to research/and provide us guidance on this item at the next meeting.
- 3. We discussed making "Neighborhood watch" magnet signs available to those members who want them.
- If I recall correctly, Sandy said she could bring them to the next meeting.
- 4. Officer Fragga will attend our meetings as his schedule permits. We will give him the meeting floor for the first 15 minutes of every meeting he can attend.
